The Larchwood City Council met for a Regular Meeting on April 14, 2025 in the Larchwood Community Center. Council Members present were Mayor Snyders, Mike Metzger, Tanner Tracy, Shane Reinke, Candie Medema and Ned Hodgson via phone. Also in attendance was Tony DeSmet.

Mayor Snyders called the Meeting to Order at 5:30 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no citizens on the Agenda.

The Consent Agenda was approved on motion by Metzger, second by Reinke. Items on the Consent Agenda were Minutes March 10, 2025 and April 7, 2025. Tony gave his Maintenance Report: Backstop fencing removed @ park, holes filled, did tree trimming in the park, cut tree grates to fit on Broadway Street, Speed sign was put up on Edgerley. Broken sewer lines repaired and lined. Set up tree cams @ dump. There have been people from other towns bringing trees, grass clippings and root balls and also mattresses and other items to the dump. There are no state or county codes for fines and the dump, so it is up to the Council to decide what to do.
