AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LARCHWOOD, IOWA,  
RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITY

TITLE II

CHAPTER 4: MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITY

ARTICLE 11 – ELECTRIC

SECTION 11.10 RATES

SECTION 1

Rates: The following monthly rates for electrical service are hereby established.

Residential:

Service charge \$15.00

Each kilowatt-hour shall be .0865 cents per kilowatt-hour

Commercial:

Service charge \$15.00

First one thousand (1000) kilowatt hours shall be .0865 per kilowatt-hour

All remaining kilowatt-hours shall be .0765 cents per kilowatt-hour

Large Power Rate:

Demand Charge if being raised from \$14.95 per KW to \$15.00 per KW

First one thousand (1000) kilowatt hours shall be .0865 cents per kilowatt-hour

All remaining kilowatt-hours shall be .0765 cents per kilowatt-hour

Minimum charge of \$1.25 per KVA of installed transformer capacity

Power Adjustment Clause

If the City of Larchwood receives a Power Adjustment Clause (PCA) from Lyon Rural Electric Cooperative, the PCA will be passed on to each individual customer at the same rate given to the City of Larchwood.

SECTION 2. REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE.

This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law. Rate will become effective on the January 2024 billing period.

Motion by Reinke , second by Medema that this ordinance be considered and given first vote for passage. Roll Call vote: AYES: Horstman, Metzger, Tracy, Medema, Reinke. NAYS: 0.

Moved by Tracy that the rule requiring that an ordinance must be considered and voted on for passage at two Council meetings prior to the meeting at which it is to be finally passed be suspended, that the ordinance be placed upon its final passage and that the ordinance does now pass, second by Reinke.
