

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARCHWOOD, IOWA COMMITTING FUNDS FOR THE NEW COMMUNITY CENTER PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Larchwood has identified a need for the New Larchwood Community Center Project, a project that will provide new recreational and community amenities and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost for the completion of the New Larchwood Community Center Project is \$4,100,000; and

WHEREAS, the City has explored funding options and intends to apply for grant funding through the Iowa Economic Development Authority (CAT), and

WHEREAS, the grant application process requires a commitment of local matching funds from the City in the amount of \$1,500,000 on hand and \$1,000,000 over the next 10 years in future commitments to cover a portion of the project's costs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to proceed with the project and commit the necessary local funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LARCHWOOD, IOWA:

Section 1. That the City Council of Larchwood does hereby officially commit the sum of \$1,500,000 on hand and \$1,000,000 over the next 10 years in local matching funds for the New Larchwood Community Center Project.

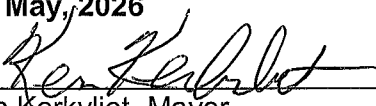
Section 2. That these committed funds shall be derived from past set asides for the project, the Local Option Sales Tax Fund, and Grand Falls Casino & Golf Resort funds and used for the purposes of completing the New Larchwood Community Center Project.

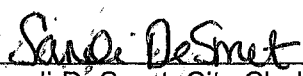
Section 3. That the City's officers, including the Mayor and City Clerks, are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to take all necessary actions to apply for, and administer, the grant funding for this project.

Section 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption. Motion by Medema to approve this Resolution 2026-18, second by Tracy. Roll call vote: Tracy-aye, Medema-aye, Hodgson-aye, Viereck-absent, Underberg-aye.
